



## OCCUPATIONAL CERTIFICATE - HEALTH PROMOTION OFFICER

### Purpose of the Qualification

The Health Promotion Officer is a new profession in the health sector that deals with prevention of diseases and improving health lifestyle. The course is made up of compulsory Knowledge, Practical Skill and Work Experience Modules.

The qualification prepares a learner to:

- Carry out basic assessments of communities, households groups and individuals.
- Provide basic health education and referrals for a wide range of services.
- Support and assist in navigating the health and social services system.

### Required Prior Learning

- Grade 10, 11 or 12 *or* Abet Level 4 with FLC *or* Ancillary Health Care NQF Level 1

### Exit Level Outcomes

- Conduct assessment of the social, physical and economic dynamics in communities.
- Conduct household assessments and identify those at risk of health related issues (Including impairments in health status).
- Provide information, education and support for healthy behaviours and appropriate home care.
- Provide psychosocial support.
- Identify and manage minor health problems.
